Hawks keep pace in Mid-State race

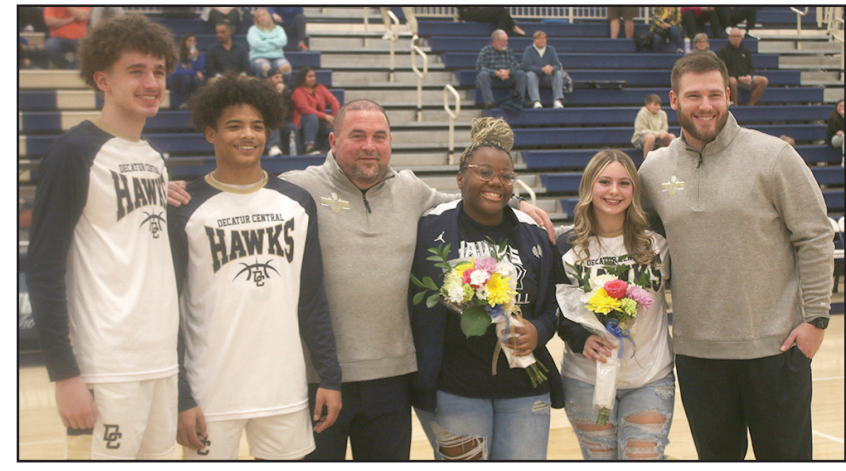
There were many things Decatur Central did right in Friday's Mid-State Conference showdown with Whiteland.
 The Hawks shot well. They dominated the boards. They played plenty of defense. They established a lead as large as 17 points late in the third quarter.
 They wound up hanging on for a 78-72 victory on senior night in the David "Doc" Rather Gymnasium.
 "The only negative that stands out is we have to learn to finish," said coach Bryan Surber after the Hawks remained in the MSC title race by improving to 5-1, a game behind 6-0 Franklin and a game ahead of 4-2 Plainfield, which fell 65-58 to Greenwood. "We can't let a team get back in it like that and win the sectional."
 The Hawks also showed plenty of balance, which was necessary, given that starters Ayden Lawson and Ty'reese Burnett were called for

their second fouls and benched in the first quarter.
 Senior KC Berry led that balanced attack with 23 points, junior forward Melakiah Cunningham notched a double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds, junior wing Eric Hopson scored 14, senior center Ayden Lawson scored 11, Burnett finished with seven and Nash Sigmund added one of DC's four 3-point baskets.
 "We had to win to stay alive in the conference," said Cunningham, who hit one 3 late in the game. "We all had to rebound. We knew that would be important for us to win."
 "I didn't make a lot of 3's, but I got in the paint a lot. We just had to attack them."
 For the most part, the Hawks did just that.
 The game was close from the start, but DC's defense helped produce a 34-28 halftime margin. The Hawks outscored the Warriors 19-9 in the second quarter and 24-16 in the third to build a 58-44 margin. Whiteland battled back, but

couldn't quite get there as the teams combined for 48 points in the final eight minutes. The Warriors did whittle the gap to 75-70 on a basket and free throw by Gavin Stubbe with 15.3 seconds to play, but that's as close as they could get.
 The Warriors showed balance of their own, as senior Wyatt McLaughlin scored 18 points, junior Ethan Edwards 17, Stubbe 16 and senior guard Jazz Bonwalt 13. Whiteland was hampered somewhat when 6-7 senior starter Akol Akol

was injured in a pile of players under the DC basket early in the fourth quarter. He walked back to the bench, but did not return to the game. A minute later, backup guard Dane Kunz turned an ankle and limped to the bench.
 "That 14 (McLaughlin) is tough playing us," Surber noted. "He scored 30 last year; 18 tonight. We thought they would struggle keeping us from the rim. Eric Hopson had a great game: 14 points and six rebounds. KC scored well and had six assists. Whiteland is a heck of a good team. This was a good win for us. I just wish we would have finished better."
 Surber lauded his seniors, saying, "KC is a four-year starter. Being able to have KC is a pleasure. When he's on, he's hard to guard. Ayden Lawson is a great captain. He's the least selfish kid we've had here in a while. We have had the two best managers forever: Hailey Hoffman and Tabi (Tabitha Mutungambara). They're great. We're sure going to miss them."

Southport's dramatic corner shot dooms host Roncalli in thriller

Visiting Southport defeated host Roncalli on a game-winning play, just the way it was drawn up.
This tense Southside rivalry boiled down on Feb. 6 to 6-4 junior Jack Turner's stunning 3-point shot from the right corner that put Southport ahead, 61-59 for the win with 13.2 seconds left.

"It (play) worked perfectly the way that Ben Rhodes (assistant) drew it up," first-year Southport coach Bill Zych said. "We brought our big guy (James Kalala) into the middle. Jack was the guy who set the screen for him, and we got the ball to him after he slipped to the corner."

The successful out-of-bounds play left Roncalli plenty of time but Southport's defense clamped down on Royals' star Drew Kegerreis who was forced to launch a shot against a double-team that had no chance of reaching the rim before the buzzer.

Southport notched its third win in four outings and snapped a Royals' three-game winning streak.

Recalling Roncalli's final defensive strategy, coach Jamin Wernke said, "We were up one point (49-48) and wanted to take care of the paint (lane). We forced them to take a tough 3. We just didn't come out with the win."

The Royals wanted to protect inside the lane because Kalala, a 6-7 sophomore, had dominated the inside with 21 points and nine rebounds. Scoring 10 points all in the second half, Turner had connected on one of three 3-point attempts before his game winning shot.

Southport gained the game's biggest lead of six points (34-28) on 6-1 junior Michael Johnson's drive with 4:20 left in the third quarter.

The Royals responded with a 9-0 run in a 140-second flurry as 6-2 forward Noah Schmalz slipped underneath for four points and Kegerreis added a 3-pointer and a driving lay-up.

Trailing 48-44, Kegerreis put together a five-point surge for the Royals' final lead, 49-48.

Kegerreis wound up with 21 points and nine rebounds with 10 points each from Schmalz and 6-7 soph Joe Taylor, who went up against Kalala.

With a 10-8 record, Roncalli's Wernke observed, "We are getting better and better and we're getting close to where we need to be. We talk all the time about taking care of the ball, getting defensive rebounds, and getting our best shot. I keep thinking the tide is going to turn all at one time."

The Royals and Cardinals were as even as the final score indicated. Roncalli hit 20 of 45 shots (44.4 percent); Southport hit 21 of 48 (43.7 percent). Southport had a 27-25 edge on the boards, and each team committed nine turnovers.

There were 12 lead changes and the game was tied four times.

Zych, in his 37th season as a head coach, is no stranger to the Southside with previous stints at Center Grove and Perry Meridian. He coached at Pike for 13 years where he never had a losing season before succeeding Eric Brand at Southport. Zych is 24 wins from 500 career wins.

"It's always different when there's a change," Zych said. "Most of these kids had not played varsity until now. If they had, it was mop-up minutes. So they had to understand what varsity basketball is about. We've had our ups and downs, but it has been a steady climb."

The Cardinals have one lone senior, guard Caleb Wolsiffer, seven juniors, and two sophomores, including Kalala, a transfer from North Carolina, but originally from the Congo.

Each team was short-handed. Roncalli was without starters Will Hegwood and Luke Selke. Zych did not start with two regular starters.

Roncalli recovered Friday from the Southport loss by dominating host Heritage Christian, 58-42.

Southport collided Saturday against visiting Hamilton Southeastern, 75-69.

Elsewhere last week, Beech Grove snapped a six-game skid with only its fourth win at Cascade, 64-54; host Center Grove dominated Jeffersonville, 71-55 behind Joe Schmitz' 21 points;

Southside sending seven semistate champs to IHSAA State Finals

Center Grove claimed four individual championships at Evansville and Roncalli snared three individual titles Saturday at New Castle in IHSAA wrestling semistates.

At Evansville, Center Grove came so close to the team title, just 8.5 points short of champion Brownsburg, 199 to 190.5.

Overall, 18 wrestlers from five Southside high schools qualified for the State Finals at Evansville, starting at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Ford Center.

At the New Castle Semistate, Roncalli was third with 96 points as Warren Central won with 148.5 points.

Roncalli's individual championships were earned by sophomore Peyton Schoettle (39-1) dominating Heather Crull of Northeastern for the 106 title, 14-1; classmate Blake Getz (38-3) downing Bradyn Volz of Eastern Hancock, 9-3 at 113; and senior Braden Getz (38-3) barely snaring the 150 title against Carson Fettig of Hamilton Heights, 5-4.

Perry Meridian senior Zach Huckaby defeated three opponents but fell to Warren Central's Waylon Cressell in the 165-title match.

Lutheran's lone wrestler, freshman Caleb Morrow, was fourth after winning his first two matches and then falling to Crull in a semi match and Cathedral's John Bissmeyer in the 106 consy match.

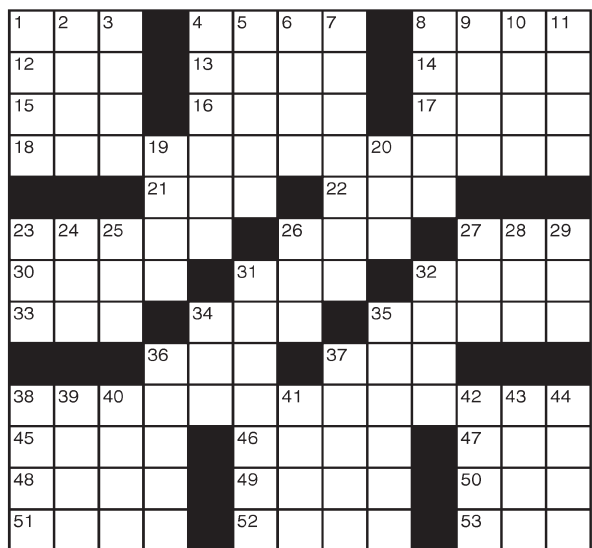
